To all Landowners.

Per Board Resolution 6.3.20.2 the District is working with CWA to perform a total island survey. This survey is to assist in evaluating an annual island wide water management plan to improve waterfowl habitat. In order to perform the survey, CWA will need the information noted below from each of the landowners.

The purpose for this survey is to gather elevations of all your important structures so that California Waterfowl can help us determine the most beneficial water levels, more effective water circulation, more productive waterfowl food sources and better-timed pump and leach cycle dates. If you want to be part of this survey you must forward your information ahead of time. If you do nothing you will gain nothing and will have little or no input on the final design and outcome of this project.

In addition, the CWA surveyor will need your permission to survey each property. Robert Eddings is heading up the project for CWA. He can be reached via email REddings@calwaterfowl.org and is happy to answer any questions.

Robert's goal is to start as soon as possible with a completion date of early July for the survey work.

- The following are items that CWA would like to receive
 - Contact information for each club
 - Plot plan of each property (this can be the plan that SRCD has for the Habitat Management Plan that is being submitted to BCDC. Contact Phelan McKinney for copies if you do not have. pmckinney@suisunrcd.org)
 - location of blinds
 - buildings, walkways, or other structures of concern if water levels were maintained higher than typical
 - properties that have the ability and/or desire to operate, at least at some level, independently from neighboring clubs
 - gate codes/keys to allow access

Your assistance in turning around this information to Robert within the next week is appreciated.
